Martes 19 Septiembre	MATH	Solve a problem bank given by the teacher, which consists of illustrating, explaining and analyzing, how to apply to real life the topic "Rounding Numbers Through Billions"

Lunes 25 Septiembre	SCIENCE	EXPERIMENT, OBSERVATION LOG. Similar to What was done with food containers. Conduct an observation of the following. Materials -3 jars, plastic or glass -cocacola, vinegar, and alcohol. -Notebook for observation Log -3 eggs Procedure - Put vinegar, coca cola, and alcohol in separate jars - Put an egg in each container. Observe changes in appearance, smell, and texture every two days and write them on your log. - When it has been 10 days ask help from your parents to take the egg out and break it. Write down the differences between the egg that was in the cocacola, alcohol and vinegar. Notate the smell and look of each egg and then get rid of it. -Write down your final observations and provide a hypothesis why eggs changed in such a way.
Martes 26 de Septiembre	READING LANGUAGE SPELLING PHONICS	All from reading Princess and Pea pg 66 -Go and read "The Princess and The Pea" pg 66 -Take out and write 5 sentences of each type (imperative, exclamatory, declarative, and interrogative) These sentences must be taken from the story. -Take out 30 words that have st, sp, sk (30 in total) These words must be taken from the story. -Take out 5 words with "CH" or "C" sound, 5 with "g" sound, 5 words that have "wh" and "sh" sound, and 10 words that have sounds of "th" and "wh"
Miércoles 27 y Jueves 28 Septiembre	SOCIAL STUDIES / ESL	Personal expositions about the 13 colonies, Massachusetts Bay Colony, The Beginning of Jamestown, John Smith and the Colonists, Colony of Plymouth. Each Student will be assigned a colony during the colonial times in the U.S.A. and present the characteristics of it in an exposition. Three main things will be evaluated. - Material to present the topic (a cardboard with illustration, spelling) -Presentation in front of the classroom. - Presentation of the research on paper. This does not need to be longer than 2 pages.
